### Internal Review and Recommendations

This submittal is an application for the renewal of an existing MS4 NPDES Permit. The submittal includes a Memorandum of Understanding between the Township and Northampton County Conservation District as well as a copy of Bethlehem Township's updated stormwater ordinance.

A Pollutant Reduction Plan Amendment request was submitted via OnBase (ID# 108259) on 5/16/23. The plan was revised in September of 2023 and submitted to DEP via on base on 9/25/23, with an OnBase ID# 122290. There had been a number of correspondences regarding the proposed plan with the final letter from DEP being sent on 12/6/23. That letter expressed concerns which DEP has requested that the Permitted be mindful of. An attachment of the letter is included below. The September 2023 version of the PRP will supersede all previously approved versions. Note that the original deadline for PRP implementation remains regardless of the authorized changes. The approval of PRP amendments does not extend the deadline.

### Public Participation

DEP will publish notice of the receipt of the NPDES permit application and a tentative decision to issue the individual NPDES permit in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* in accordance with 25 Pa. Code § 92a.82. Upon publication in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin*, DEP will accept written comments from interested persons for a 30-day period (which may be extended for one additional 15-day period at DEP's discretion), which will be considered in making a final decision on the application. or petition for a public hearing with respect to the application. A public hearing may be held if DEP determines that there is significant public interest in holding a hearing. If a hearing is held, notice of the hearing will be published in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* at least 30 days prior to the hearing and in at least one newspaper of general circulation within the geographical area of the discharge.
