**Internal Review and Recommendations**

The applicant is requesting renewal of an individual NPDES MS4 permit to discharge stormwater to Monocacy Creek (HQ-CWF/MF), Tributaries 3385, 3386 & 3388 to Monocacy Creek (HQ-CWF/MF) and Tributary 3633 to Catasauqua Creek (CWF/MF) in state water plan basin 02-C (Lower Lehigh River). As per the Department's current existing use list, the receiving streams do not have existing use classifications that are more protective than their designated uses.

All receiving streams are within 5 miles of waters impaired for siltation/suspended solids due to urban runoff and storm sewer systems (Lehigh River & Catasauqua Creek). The permittee was required to develop and submit a Pollutant Reduction Plan (PRP) with the permit application describing how 10% of their existing sediment loading to the receiving streams will be removed within five years of the permit effective date (see Appendix E of the permit). The permittee shall also implement Pollutant Control Measures (PCMs) within the storm sewershed of any outfall that discharges to waters impaired from PCBs as described in Appendix C of the permit.

The previously issued permit expired on September 30, 2019 and the renewal had been on hold for PRP revisions.

Public Participation

DEP will publish notice of the receipt of the NPDES permit application and a tentative decision to issue the individual NPDES permit in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* in accordance with 25 Pa. Code § 92a.82. Upon publication in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin*, DEP will accept written comments from interested persons for a 30-day period (which may be extended for one additional 15-day period at DEP's discretion), which will be considered in making a final decision on the application. Any person may request or petition for a public hearing with respect to the application. A public hearing may be held if DEP determines that there is significant public interest in holding a hearing. If a hearing is held, notice of the hearing will be published in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* at least 30 days prior to the hearing and in at least one newspaper of general circulation within the geographical area of the discharge.
