Internal Review and Recommendations

South Whitehall Township is located in central Lehigh County. The Township is mostly developed land consisting of commercial and industrial uses and smaller areas of residential. The Township is located in multiple watersheds, the Lower Jordan Creek, Coplay Creek and Little Lehigh River Watersheds, with sediment impaired downstream waters including the Little Lehigh Creek, Coplay Creek, Jordan Creek, Lehigh River, and Little Cedar Creek. PRP and TMDL plans have been included in the submittal to address stream impairments. The plans incorporate retrofits to existing basins to increase water quality improvement efficiency. My recommendation is to approve the application and grant MS4 permit renewal.

Public Participation

DEP will publish notice of the receipt of the NPDES permit application and a tentative decision to issue the individual NPDES permit in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* in accordance with 25 Pa. Code § 92a.82. Upon publication in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin*, DEP will accept written comments from interested persons for a 30-day period (which may be extended for one additional 15-day period at DEP's discretion), which will be considered in making a final decision on the application. Any person may request or petition for a public hearing with respect to the application. A public hearing may be held if DEP determines that there is significant public interest in holding a hearing. If a hearing is held, notice of the hearing will be published in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* at least 30 days prior to the hearing and in at least one newspaper of general circulation within the geographical area of the discharge.
