### Internal Review and Recommendations

In order to meet their Pollutant Reduction Plan requirements, the applicant has proposed to implement a number of stormwater BMPs to include a raingarden, pervious pavement, basin retrofitting, bioswale construction and filtering practices. The plan is projected to remove 49,144 lbs. sediment annually and therefore meet the goal of 48,853 lbs/year.

#### Public Participation

DEP will publish notice of the receipt of the NPDES permit application and a tentative decision to issue the individual NPDES permit in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* in accordance with 25 Pa. Code § 92a.82. Upon publication in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin*, DEP will accept written comments from interested persons for a 30-day period (which may be extended for one additional 15-day period at DEP's discretion), which will be considered in making a final decision on the application. Any person may request or petition for a public hearing with respect to the application. A public hearing may be held if DEP determines that there is significant public interest in holding a hearing. If a hearing is held, notice of the hearing will be published in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* at least 30 days prior to the hearing and in at least one newspaper of general circulation within the geographical area of the discharge.
