



### Internal Review and Recommendations

Lower Milford Township in Lehigh County has applied for a NPDES MS4 Permit renewal. The original pollutant reduction plan (PRP) shall continue to be implemented. Any outstanding pollutant control measures (PCM's) are to be completed. The municipality has experienced 2.3% growth between 2010 (3,775) and 2020 (3,861). The urbanized area is limited to the Northeast section of the Municipality and appears to cover about 15%-20% of the land area.

**Internal Review and Recommendations**

**Public Participation**

DEP will publish notice of the receipt of the NPDES permit application and a tentative decision to issue the individual NPDES permit in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* in accordance with 25 Pa. Code § 92a.82. Upon publication in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin*, DEP will accept written comments from interested persons for a 30-day period (which may be extended for one additional 15-day period at DEP's discretion), which will be considered in making a final decision on the application. Any person may request or petition for a public hearing with respect to the application. A public hearing may be held if DEP determines that there is significant public interest in holding a hearing. If a hearing is held, notice of the hearing will be published in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* at least 30 days prior to the hearing and in at least one newspaper of general circulation within the geographical area of the discharge.
