Internal Review and Recommendations

Note that this MS4 had previously been covered under a PAG13, however, due to compliance issues will now have an Individual Permit. The previous permit had expired on 4/8/2018.

The Pollutant Reduction Plan proposes construction of two bio-retention basins which are projected to remove 31,214.69 lbs./year of sediment. The required reduction is 20,630 lbs./year.

The borough also proposes to implement a street sweeping program but will not meet the required frequency to obtain MS4 sediment removal credit.

The Borough has also been part of a potential "start-up" Lackawanna County stormwater collaborative effort.

Public Participation

DEP will publish notice of the receipt of the NPDES permit application and a tentative decision to issue the individual NPDES permit in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* in accordance with 25 Pa. Code § 92a.82. Upon publication in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin*, DEP will accept written comments from interested persons for a 30-day period (which may be extended for one additional 15-day period at DEP's discretion), which will be considered in making a final decision on the application. Any person may request or petition for a public hearing with respect to the application. A public hearing may be held if DEP determines that there is significant public interest in holding a hearing. If a hearing is held, notice of the hearing will be published in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* at least 30 days prior to the hearing and in at least one newspaper of general circulation within the geographical area of the discharge.
