Internal Review and Recommendations

1. Your plan proposes stream restoration BMPs. Please be advised that the final designs for stream restoration BMPs should be in general accordance with DEP's "Considerations of Stream Restoration Projects" document, available at www.dep.pa.gov/ms4.
2. Please be advised that calculations for proposed BMPs with an effectiveness value that is dependent on the outcome of soils testing should be revised as more information becomes available to accurately reflect the BMP that is being implemented.

Public Participation

DEP will publish notice of the receipt of the NPDES permit application and a tentative decision to issue the individual NPDES permit in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* in accordance with 25 Pa. Code § 92a.82. Upon publication in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin*, DEP will accept written comments from interested persons for a 30-day period (which may be extended for one additional 15-day period at DEP's discretion), which will be considered in making a final decision on the application. Any person may request or petition for a public hearing with respect to the application. A public hearing may be held if DEP determines that there is significant public interest in holding a hearing. If a hearing is held, notice of the hearing will be published in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* at least 30 days prior to the hearing and in at least one newspaper of general circulation within the geographical area of the discharge.
