Internal Review and Recommendations

Per 40 CFR § 122.33, and PA Title 25 § 92a.3, Capital Region Water (the applicant) is required to seek coverage under an NPDES permit issued by the state of Pennsylvania. Due to the applicant's discharge to waters requiring a TMDL Plan, the applicant has submitted an application for coverage under an individual permit. Per PA Title 25 § 92a.54, the applicant is eligible for permit coverage.

The applicant discharges to the following waters: Susquehanna River (WWF, MF), Paxton Creek (WWF, MF), Asylum Run (WWF, MF), Spring Creek (CWF, MF), and Unnamed Tributary to Spring Creek.

During the previous permit term, the applicant submitted a combined Local Impairment Reduction Plan, Chesapeake Bay Pollutant Reduction Plan, and TMDL Plan. The plan was a joint plan with Lower Paxton Township and Susquehanna Township and combines the Chesapeake Bay PRP and Paxton Creek Watershed TMDL Plan. The plan was approved on 8/1/2020 and expires 7/31/2025.

As a result of draft permit comments submitted by the applicant during the previous permit term, changes were made to the language in the previous permit. This draft permit incorporated those changes to reflect the language in the previous permit. Specifically, changes were made to Part A.I.B., Part C.I.B.3.d.(3), Part C.I.6.b., and Part C.I.6.c.(2).

There are no unresolved violations associated with the applicant that would affect issuance of coverage.

It is recommended that individual permit coverage is granted in accordance with 40 CFR §123.35.

Internal Review and Recommendations

Public Participation

DEP will publish notice of the receipt of the NPDES permit application and a tentative decision to issue the individual NPDES permit in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* in accordance with 25 Pa. Code § 92a.82. Upon publication in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin*, DEP will accept written comments from interested persons for a 30-day period (which may be extended for one additional 15-day period at DEP's discretion), which will be considered in making a final decision on the application. Any person may request or petition for a public hearing with respect to the application. A public hearing may be held if DEP determines that there is significant public interest in holding a hearing. If a hearing is held, notice of the hearing will be published in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* at least 30 days prior to the hearing and in at least one newspaper of general circulation within the geographical area of the discharge.
