Internal Review and Recommendations

Per 40 CFR § 122.33, and PA Title 25 § 92a.3, South Middleton Township (the applicant) is required to seek coverage under an NPDES permit issued by the state of Pennsylvania. Due to the applicant's discharge to special protection waters, the applicant has submitted an application for coverage under an individual permit. Per PA Title 25 § 92a.54, the applicant is eligible for permit coverage.

The applicant discharges to the following waters: Letort Spring Run (EV, MF), Hogestown Run (CWF, MF), Yellow Breeches Creek (HQ-CWF, MF), Alexanders Spring Creek (CWF, MF) and Conodoguinet Creek (WWF, MF).

During the previous permit term, the applicant submitted a Chesapeake Bay Pollutant Reduction Plan. The plan was approved on 5/1/2021 and expires 4/30/2026

There are no unresolved violations associated with the applicant that would affect issuance of coverage.

It is recommended that individual permit coverage is granted in accordance with 40 CFR §123.35.

Public Participation

DEP will publish notice of the receipt of the NPDES permit application and a tentative decision to issue the individual NPDES permit in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* in accordance with 25 Pa. Code § 92a.82. Upon publication in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin*, DEP will accept written comments from interested persons for a 30-day period (which may be extended for one additional 15-day period at DEP's discretion), which will be considered in making a final decision on the application. Any person may request or petition for a public hearing with respect to the application. A public hearing may be held if DEP determines that there is significant public interest in holding a hearing. If a hearing is held, notice of the hearing will be published in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* at least 30 days prior to the hearing and in at least one newspaper of general circulation within the geographical area of the discharge.
