**Internal Review and Recommendations**

Per 40 CFR § 122.33, and PA Title 25 § 92a.3, Antrim Township is required to seek coverage under a NPDES permit issued by the state of Pennsylvania. Due to Special Protection waters (UNT to Muddy Run HQ-CWF), Antrim Township has submitted an application for coverage under an individual permit. Per PA Title 25 § 92a.54, Antrim Township is eligible for permit coverage.

Antrim Township discharges to 3 receiving waters:

Unnamed Tributary to Conococheague Creek (WWF, MF), Unnamed Tributary to Muddy Run (HQ-CWF, MF), and Unnamed Tributary of Paddy Run (WWF, MF)

According to the MS4 Requirements Table, Antrim Township is subject to the following IP appendix requirements:

Appendix D for Chesapeake Bay nutrients/sediment impairment

Appendix E for UNT to Muddy Run sediment impairment

To comply with Appendix D and E, Antrim Township has previously submitted a Pollutant Reduction Plan.

The plan was approved by DEP on June 22, 2018.

There are no unresolved violations associated with Antrim Township that would affect issuance of coverage.

It is recommended that individual permit coverage is granted in accordance with 40 CFR § 123.35.

**Internal Review and Recommendations**

Public Participation

DEP will publish notice of the receipt of the NPDES permit application and a tentative decision to issue the individual NPDES permit in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* in accordance with 25 Pa. Code § 92a.82. Upon publication in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin*, DEP will accept written comments from interested persons for a 30-day period (which may be extended for one additional 15-day period at DEP's discretion), which will be considered in making a final decision on the application. Any person may request or petition for a public hearing with respect to the application. A public hearing may be held if DEP determines that there is significant public interest in holding a hearing. If a hearing is held, notice of the hearing will be published in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* at least 30 days prior to the hearing and in at least one newspaper of general circulation within the geographical area of the discharge.
