**Internal Review and Recommendations**

Ferguson Township has submitted an application to renew the existing NPDES permit for its MS4 system.

DEP has received Ferguson Township's PRP / TMDL Plan Final Report, dated September 23, 2025. The pollutant load reduction requirement was 59,525 lbs/yr total suspended solids. The Piney Ridge Stream restoration project generated 35,650 lbs/year of TSS load reduction. Additionally, the Duck Pond Channel, a stream restoration project shared between The Pennsylvania State University (PAI134807), College Township (PAI134803), Harris Township (PAI134801), and Ferguson Township, allotted an additional 49,455 lbs/yr of TSS of the 115,000 lbs/year total project "balance". Through both BMPs Ferguson Township achieved a total TSS load reduction of 85,105 lbs/yr.

DEP recommends that the renewed permit is drafted so that the permittee shall continue to maintain and implement all BMPs outlined in the existing PRP in full working order to continue to meet the achieved pollutant reductions.

DEP will publish notice of the receipt of the NPDES permit application and a tentative decision to issue the individual NPDES permit in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* in accordance with 25 Pa. Code § 92a.82. Upon publication in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin*, DEP will accept written comments from interested persons for a 30-day period (which may be extended for one additional 15-day period at DEP's discretion), which will be considered in making a final decision on the application. Any person may request or petition for a public hearing with respect to the application. A public hearing may be held if DEP determines that there is significant public interest in holding a hearing. If a hearing is held, notice of the hearing will be published in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* at least 30 days prior to the hearing and in at least one newspaper of general circulation within the geographical area of the discharge.
