Internal Review and Recommendations

Spring Township has submitted an application to renew the existing NPDES permit for its MS4 system.

DEP received Spring Township's PRP / TMDL Plan Final Report, dated September 25, 2024. The pollutant load reduction requirements were 10,174 lbs/yr total suspended solids, 90 lbs/yr total nitrogen, and 9 lbs/yr total phosphorus. Through BMP implementation, Spring Township achieved pollutant load reductions of 13,580 lbs/yr total suspended solids, 429 lbs/yr total nitrogen, and 24 lbs/yr total phosphorus. DEP sent a letter dated December 12, 2024 to Spring Township acknowledging that the Final Report documents compliance with the permit's pollutant load reduction requirements.

DEP recommends that the renewed permit is drafted so that the permittee shall continue to maintain and implement all BMPs outlined in the existing PRP in full working order to continue to meet the achieved pollutant reductions.

Public Participation

DEP will publish notice of the receipt of the NPDES permit application and a tentative decision to issue the individual NPDES permit in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* in accordance with 25 Pa. Code § 92a.82. Upon publication in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin*, DEP will accept written comments from interested persons for a 30-day period (which may be extended for one additional 15-day period at DEP's discretion), which will be considered in making a final decision on the application. Any person may request or petition for a public hearing with respect to the application. A public hearing may be held if DEP determines that there is significant public interest in holding a hearing. If a hearing is held, notice of the hearing will be published in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* at least 30 days prior to the hearing and in at least one newspaper of general circulation within the geographical area of the discharge.
