

Internal Review and Recommendations

- A timely Individual MS4 NPDES Permit renewal application from Leetsdale Borough was received by DEP on 6/27/2024
- Leetsdale Borough has an individual MS4 NPDES permit due to a stormwater outfall discharging to a High-Quality designated stream
- The provided storm sewer system map (Figure 1) shows the furthest downstream outfalls for streams that stormwater is discharged to
 - Outfall 001 to Ohio River which has a 25 PA Code Chapter 93 Warm Water Fishes designation and is impaired for pathogens, polychlorinated biphenyls (PCBs), and dioxin all from an unknown source
 - Outfall 004 to Big Sewickley Creek which has a 25 PA Code Chapter 93 Trout Stocking designation and is not impaired
 - Outfall 006 to Little Sewickley Creek which has a 25 PA Code Chapter 93 High-Quality Trout Stocking designation and is impaired for an unknown cause thought to come from highway/road/ bridge runoff (non-construction related) (source: 2024 Integrated Report)
- No Pollutant Reduction Plan (PRP) is required for the MS4 at this time
- The Ohio River has a TMDL for PCB and Chlordane in which Leetsdale Borough does not have a wasteload allocation
- The Borough has a stormwater management ordinance enacted on 11/8/2018 consistent with the 2022 DEP Model Ordinance

Public Participation

DEP will publish notice of the receipt of the NPDES permit application and a tentative decision to issue the individual NPDES permit in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* in accordance with 25 Pa. Code § 92a.82. Upon publication in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin*, DEP will accept written comments from interested persons for a 30-day period (which may be extended for one additional 15-day period at DEP's discretion), which will be considered in making a final decision on the application. Any person may request or petition for a public hearing with respect to the application. A public hearing may be held if DEP determines that there is significant public interest in holding a hearing. If a hearing is held, notice of the hearing will be published in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* at least 30 days prior to the hearing and in at least one newspaper of general circulation within the geographical area of the discharge.
