Internal Review and Recommendations

The permittee will be subjected to Appendix E (Impaired waters nutrient/sediment) requirements in the next permit cycle due to having MS4 outfalls to six streams in the municipality that are impaired due to siltation or nutrients.

The submitted Pollution Reduction Plan (PRP) is technically accurate and, if implemented, should meet pollutant reduction goals in the watershed.

Complete mapping was submitted with adequate detail.

A Data Audit Inspection was conducted by the Department in on August 13, 2019.

MS4 Progress Reports (annual) have all been submitted timely and were technically complete.

There are currently no open violations listed in EFACTS for the permittee (10/08/2020).

Public Participation

DEP will publish notice of the receipt of the NPDES permit application and a tentative decision to issue the individual NPDES permit in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* in accordance with 25 Pa. Code § 92a.82. Upon publication in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin*, DEP will accept written comments from interested persons for a 30-day period (which may be extended for one additional 15-day period at DEP's discretion), which will be considered in making a final decision on the application. Any person may request or petition for a public hearing with respect to the application. A public hearing may be held if DEP determines that there is significant public interest in holding a hearing. If a hearing is held, notice of the hearing will be published in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* at least 30 days prior to the hearing and in at least one newspaper of general circulation within the geographical area of the discharge.
