**Internal Review and Recommendations**

A Data Audit (DAI-R) last occurred on September 17, 2021. No major issues were noted.

No new outfalls were indicated in the renewal application. Therefore, there are no anti-degradation requirements for this renewal.

This renewal required the permittee to develop and implement a PRP for sediment and nutrient reduction. The plan was reviewed with the renewal application and is deemed acceptable.

No open violations were listed in EFACTS for this client (6/07/2022).

Public Participation

DEP will publish notice of the receipt of the NPDES permit application and a tentative decision to issue the individual NPDES permit in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* in accordance with 25 Pa. Code § 92a.82. Upon publication in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin*, DEP will accept written comments from interested persons for a 30-day period (which may be extended for one additional 15-day period at DEP's discretion), which will be considered in making a final decision on the application. Any person may request or petition for a public hearing with respect to the application. A public hearing may be held if DEP determines that there is significant public interest in holding a hearing. If a hearing is held, notice of the hearing will be published in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* at least 30 days prior to the hearing and in at least one newspaper of general circulation within the geographical area of the discharge.
