Internal Review and Recommendations

An incomplete renewal application was received on 9/18/2018, which was withdrawn and resubmitted on 9/13/2018, which was also incomplete due in large part to lack of a PRP. On 12/22/2021, a COA was executed which gave a schedule for submission of the PRP. The final PRP was submitted on 10/5/2022.

The Pollution Reduction Plan (PRP) is for sediment impairment in UNT 62387 to Lake Erie (locally known as Five Mile Creek) and its tributaries numbered 62388, 62389, and 62390. The proposed PRP plans to meet their sediment reduction goal by doing streambank restoration project spanning approximately 700 LF in Rolling Ridge Park.

There are currently no open violations listed in EFACTS for this permittee (10/11/2022).

Public Participation

DEP will publish notice of the receipt of the NPDES permit application and a tentative decision to issue the individual NPDES permit in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* in accordance with 25 Pa. Code § 92a.82. Upon publication in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin*, DEP will accept written comments from interested persons for a 30-day period (which may be extended for one additional 15-day period at DEP's discretion), which will be considered in making a final decision on the application. Any person may request or petition for a public hearing with respect to the application. A public hearing may be held if DEP determines that there is significant public interest in holding a hearing. If a hearing is held, notice of the hearing will be published in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* at least 30 days prior to the hearing and in at least one newspaper of general circulation within the geographical area of the discharge.
