Summary of Review

The applicant is requesting a renewal of their NPDES permit to discharge stormwater associated with industrial activity to an Little Pocono Creek, a HQ-CWF, MF (High Quality-Cold Water Fishes, Migratory Fish) designated receiving stream in State Water Plan Basin 1-E (Brodhead Creek). As per the Department's current existing use list, the receiving stream does not have an existing use classification that is more protective than its designated use.

The stormwater is directed by topography toward south side to outfall (001 & 002) and then discharge to little Pocono Creek. Outfall 001 is pond which rarely discharge and is reported as No discharge in eDMR report.

The permittee maintains no exposure conditions at the site facility since most industrial activities happens inside buildings. Potential risk of spills and leaks still exist because this industry uses various aboveground and underground storage tanks.

The facility is categorized by SIC codes 3444, 3449, and 3499 (Manufacturing – Fabricated Metal Products, Except Machinery and Transportation Equipment, and Coating, Engraving, and Allied Services) and falls under **Appendix U** monitoring requirements of the PAG-03 General Permit. **Appendix U** of the latest (2023) PAG-03 permit includes semiannual sampling/reporting exist for pH, Total Nitrogen, Total Phosphorus, Total suspended Solids (TSS) and Oil & Grease, Total Aluminum, Nitrate+ Nitrite- N, Total Iron and Total Zinc. Benchmarks exist for TSS, pH, Oil & Grease and Nitrate + Nitrite- N.

Benchmark values are not effluent limitations, and exceedances do not constitute permit violations. However, if the permittee's sampling demonstrates exceedances of benchmark values for two or more consecutive monitoring periods, the permittee shall take action in accordance with Part C. V. F. of the permit. A corrective action plan must be submitted to DEP

if the discharge concentration for the parameters exceeds the benchmark values for two or more consecutive monitoring periods.

Limits for Oil & Grease of (30.0mg/L) and pH (6.0- 9.0 SU) are added to this permit based on Chapter 95.2 regulations.

A new PPC plan dated October 2023 was supplied with this application.

Field inspection was performed October 05, 2022, and no violations were reported.

WMS Query by client report was performed August 22, 2024, and no violations exist.

Public Participation

DEP will publish notice of the receipt of the NPDES permit application and a tentative decision to issue the individual NPDES permit in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* in accordance with 25 Pa. Code § 92a.82. Upon publication in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin*, DEP will accept written comments from interested persons for a 30-day period (which may be extended for one additional 15-day period at DEP's discretion), which will be considered in making a final decision on the application. Any person may request or petition for a public hearing with respect to the application. A public hearing may be held if DEP determines that there is significant public interest in holding a hearing. If a hearing is held, notice of the hearing will be published in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* at least 30 days prior to the hearing and in at least one newspaper of general circulation within the geographical area of the discharge.
