**Summary of Review**

The applicant/permittee is requesting renewal of an existing individual NPDES permit to discharge Stormwater associated with the industrial activity, ~~from existing Outfall 001. The receiving stream is~~ an unnamed tributary to Nesquehoning Creek. ~~a creek is classified as~~ High Quality - Cold Water fishes (HQ-CWF) designated receiving stream in State water Plan 2-B. As per by the d the Department's existing use list, the receiving stream does not have an existing use that is more protective than the designated use.

Operations at this facility are categorized by SIC code 2821 (Plastics Materials & Resins) and falls under **Appendix F** monitoring requirements for PAG\_03 general permit. ~~The stormwater Part C requirements include Best Management Practices (BMPS), Routine Inspections, Preparedness, Prevention and Contingency Plan, and stormwater monitoring requirements.~~

S. Semi-annual monitoring/reporting are required for ~~requirements are for~~ Total Phosphorous, Total Nitrogen, Total Aluminum, Total Iron, Total Lead, and Total Zinc, Chemical Oxygen Demand (COD), Total Suspended solids (TSS), pH, Nitrate+ Nitrite- Nitrogen.

Benchmark values exist for COD, TSS, Nitrate + Nitrite-Nitrogen, and pH. A benchmark value is the concentration of a pollutant in stormwater discharges that serves as a threshold for the determination of whether existing site BMPs are effective in controlling stormwater pollution. The benchmark values can be found in Part C. V. F. of the permit. A corrective action plan must be submitted to DEP if the discharge concentration for the parameters exceed the benchmark values for two or more consecutive monitoring periods.

Public Participation

DEP will publish notice of the receipt of the NPDES permit application and a tentative decision to issue the individual NPDES permit in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* in accordance with 25 Pa. Code § 92a.82. Upon publication in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin*, DEP will accept written comments from interested persons for a 30-day period (which may be extended for one additional 15-day period at DEP's discretion), which will be considered in making a final decision on the application. Any person may request or petition for a public hearing with respect to the application. A public hearing may be held if DEP determines that there is significant public interest in holding a hearing. If a hearing is held, notice of the hearing will be published in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* at least 30 days prior to the hearing and in at least one newspaper of general circulation within the geographical area of the discharge.
