**Summary of Review**

The applicant is requesting coverage under an existing Individual NPDES permit to discharge stormwater associated with an industrial activity from existing Outfall 001. The receiving stream, Iron Run, is classified as a High Quality, Cold Water Fishes (HQ-CWF) designated receiving stream in State Water Plan 2-C. Per the Department's current existing use list, the receiving stream does not have an existing use that is more protective than the designated use.

The operations at this facility are categorized by SIC Code 3085 (Plastic Bottles) and falls under Appendix S monitoring and limit requirements. The Stormwater Part C requirements include Best Management Practices (BMPs), Routine Inspections, Preparedness, Prevention, and Contingency Plan, and Stormwater Monitoring Requirements. Benchmark values exist for TSS. The benchmark value can be found in Part C. V. F. of the permit. A corrective action plan must be submitted to DEP if the discharge concentration for the parameters exceed the benchmark values for two or more consecutive monitoring periods.

The application was received on 08/03/2022. A Compliance check was completed on 10/11/2022. There are 2 open violations for the facility:

- Violation ID 968634 - NPDES - Failure to submit NPDES renewal application at least 180 days prior to expiration or later approved date
- Violation 968635 - NPDES - Failure to submit monitoring report(s) or properly complete monitoring reports

Public Participation

DEP will publish notice of the receipt of the NPDES permit application and a tentative decision to issue the individual NPDES permit in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* in accordance with 25 Pa. Code § 92a.82. Upon publication in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin*, DEP will accept written comments from interested persons for a 30-day period (which may be extended for one additional 15-day period at DEP's discretion), which will be considered in making a final decision on the application.
