

FIELD LOG –

Weeks of June 2 and June 9, 2014

- Continuous Instream Monitors that collect temperature, specific conductance, pH and dissolved oxygen data continue to be maintained and collect data. Data collected on the Juniata River at Newport and Lewistown Narrows started to show elevated pH values prior to the major rain event that occurred the week of June 9.
- Pre-spawn adult smallmouth bass collections are complete. Pre-spawn bass will be tested for contaminants and thiamine (Vitamin B).
- Passive samplers that collect emerging contaminant information have been deployed in previous weeks at all proposed Susquehanna River locations. Most passive samplers were retrieved the week of June 9. Heavy rain and high water has postponed the retrieval or the remainder of the samplers until the week of June 16.
- Semi-quantitative or community level fish surveys are scheduled to begin the week of June 23.
