The Pennsylvania Water Quality Network (WQN) is a statewide, fixed station water quality sampling system operated by Department of Environmental Protection's (DEP) Bureau of Clean Water (BCW). It is designed to assess both the quality of Pennsylvania's surface waters and the effectiveness of the water quality management program. See DWQS WQN for details.
